

RELATIONSHIP CHART (For TAF Only)
(KEESM 2220)

To meet the living with relative requirement for TAF as a blood relative (KEESM 2220), the relationship between the caretaker and the deprived child must be within the fifth degree of kinship as defined by civil law. The diagram below illustrates the relationship of persons to the deprived child who is shown in a rectangle. Persons who are within the allowable degree of kinship are shown in circles. Persons not within the allowable degree of kinship are in a triangle. A Roman numeral indicates the degree of kinship of each person to the deprived child.

Note that in accordance with policy, verification of relationship to the deprived child is required in all non-parental situations. There is ineligibility if the relationship cannot be documented.
