- * Determine FS household size by including all members coded IN, DF, DI, or SH on SEPA.
- * These amounts will change each October when FS Gross and Net Income Limits are increased. However, consumers do not need to be notified of the new amount until the time of the next review or IR, whichever comes first.
- * The 130% Reporting Threshold is automatically entered on KAECSES Notices as of 8/15/06. The system will use the latest benefit month known for the case for food stamps to determine the household size and 130% amount.

Example 1: Process case on 8/16, September latest benefit month. System will use household size in September, and use the 130% amount from the List Benefit Standards - FS Table that ends September 30.

Example 2: Case is processed 8/28. Latest benefit month is October. System will use household size in October, and will pull 130% amount from 10/1 List Benefit Standards - FS Table.
