MEDICAL DISABILITY

What has changed?

SRS and KHPA have created a program where you may be able to receive full Medicaid benefits while you are waiting for Social Security to make a decision about your disability.

How <u>long</u> will this process take?

The process should take no longer than 90 days from the date of your application.

How does the program work?

- You complete an application and meet eligibility rules.
- Your case is assigned to a Development Team who will work with you to create a file containing all of your medical information.
- When complete, your file will be sent to a Disability Review Team who will determine if you meet the definition of disabled.
- If it is determined you have a disability, you will be eligible for Medicaid assistance.
- If it is determined you are not disabled, but that you do have a substantial health limitation, you may be eligible for MediKan assistance.

What do I have to do?

- You must complete an application.
- You must sign papers that will allow your health care providers to release information to SRS staff, Development Team, and Disability Review Team.
- You must attend all appointments that are scheduled for you, such as:
 - Telephone consultation
 - Medical exams
 - Interviews
- You must provide all information requested within the time frames set for you.
