

## INSTRUCTIONS

You have applied for MEDICAID and/or MEDIKAN with DCF. You have also stated that you are disabled and may not be able to work. The Presumptive Medical Disability Determination process is a way for you to get benefits, if you qualify. This is NOT the Social Security process for benefits. If you have not applied for Social Security benefits, you must do so as soon as possible or you will not receive these presumptive benefits. If you qualify with DCF and KDHE, you will receive presumptive Medicaid or MediKan benefits while your Social Security application is being processed. The Presumptive Medical Disability process can take up to 90 days and includes other eligibility factors that your DCF case worker handles.

Fill out completely; please print. Failure to complete the form could result in a delay in the determination of your disability or in an unfavorable decision.
- HIPAA Compliant Authorization to Release Information**  
Sign and date.

Use this envelope to return the PMDD Questionnaire and HIPAA Authorization. You DO NOT need to attach postage or include these instructions.
