ONE-TIME PAYMENT FOR YOUTH

Youth ages **18-26** who have experienced out-of-home placement after age 14 may be eligible for a one-time pandemic relief payment.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Experienced out-of-home placement at or after age 14 in the custody of Child Welfare, Juvenile Justice, or Tribal Authority
- Current resident of Kansas
- Age **18 or older**, no longer in custody, and **under the age of 27** at the time of applying for the Pandemic Relief Payment
- No longer engaged in the Independent Living Program or the Independent Living Re-entry Program

Applications Open:

July 1 - Aug. 31, 2021

Additional Information:

- You will need State-issued ID, birth certificate, or social security card
- You can fill out the application online or you can download a paper copy
- Payments will be issued starting Sept. 1-30, 2021
