#### Goal

The goal is to provide DCF customers with a realistic work environment in preparation for permanent employment.

Employers provide program participants with a training environment to develop trade skills and successful work habits.

Meanwhile, participants are given the opportunity to establish references and develop a current work history to use for securing permanent employment.

## Hiring

Employers who establish themselves as a training site are awarded the opportunity to train potential employees at no risk and at no cost.

Employers will then have the advantage of hiring for vacancies from a labor pool whose work habits and skills have been previewed and proven. This type of partnership can aid an employer in job matching and employee turn-over.

### Placement

Employers will be matched with participants who are ideal candidates for the job site. Staff consider the necessary skills, prior work experience, and training when matching participants with an employer.

Employers have the opportunity to interview all potential participants to discuss goals and expectations. DCF staff are available to address employers' and participants' needs at any time during the training process.

For the benefit of the employer, successful employment habits will be introduced and reinforced with the participant before and during job placement.
