**CLARIFICATION** – Electronic signature techniques including typed signatures will be considered valid and legal signatures to apply for Food Assistance, TANF or Child Care.

Submittal of a paper or online application with name, address and signature shall be considered a request for assistance. A telephonic signature and electronic signature including typed signature is a valid and legal signature to request assistance.

Electronic signature techniques include, but are not limited to the following:

- Typed signatures
- Signatures signed using cursor, finger or stylus
- Signatures created on PDF format
- Signatures on electronic pad
