Monthly and Daily Interface Files

KDHE runs interface files monthly and daily to identify KDHE consumers who meet the stated criteria above. A list of those identified persons is sent to the Kansas Department of Education (KSDE). Then, KSDE determines eligibility for Free and Reduced School Lunch.

• The monthly file runs the second workday of each month.

Ex: The file that runs in July 2022 will look for clients that satisfy the criteria for August 2022.
